Model now in place with the inclusion of licensing officers, NPT and response officers. Figures show a reduction in nearly all violent crime types for this period.

Shoplifting

LPA priority- Retail Crime Team. National trend.

Retrospective facial recognition software now in place as standard practice. Repeat offenders treated as a daily priority. More timely arrests and greater demand reduction.

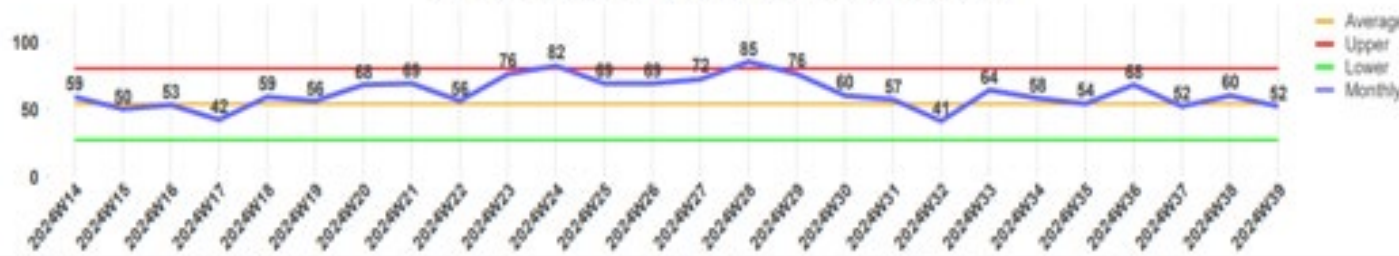

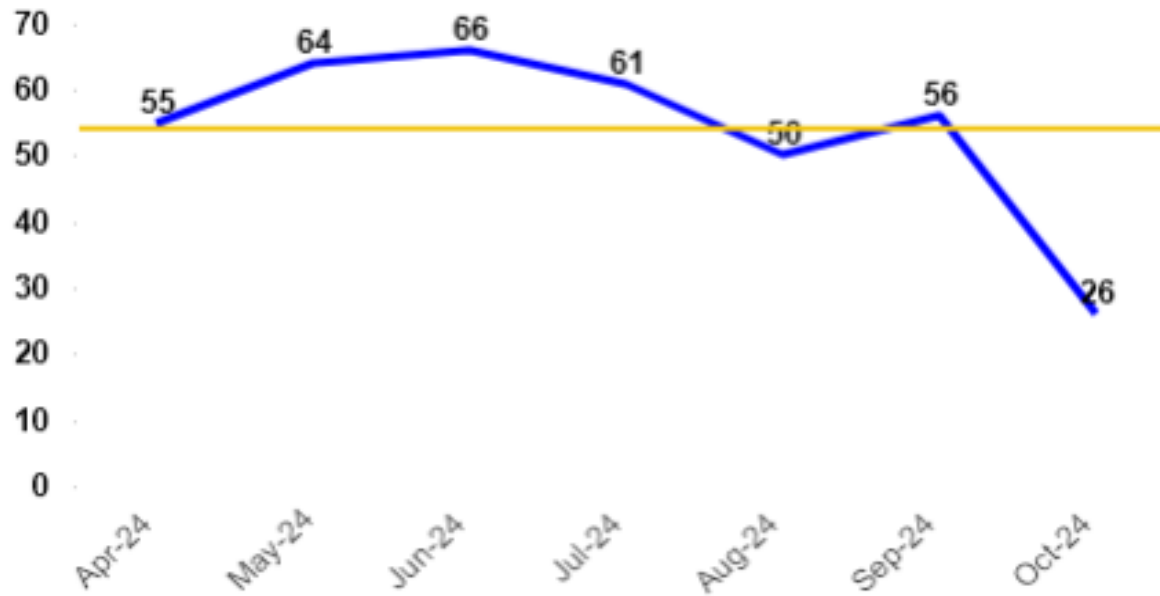
Crime Control Chart, by Year & Week (Completed Weeks only)



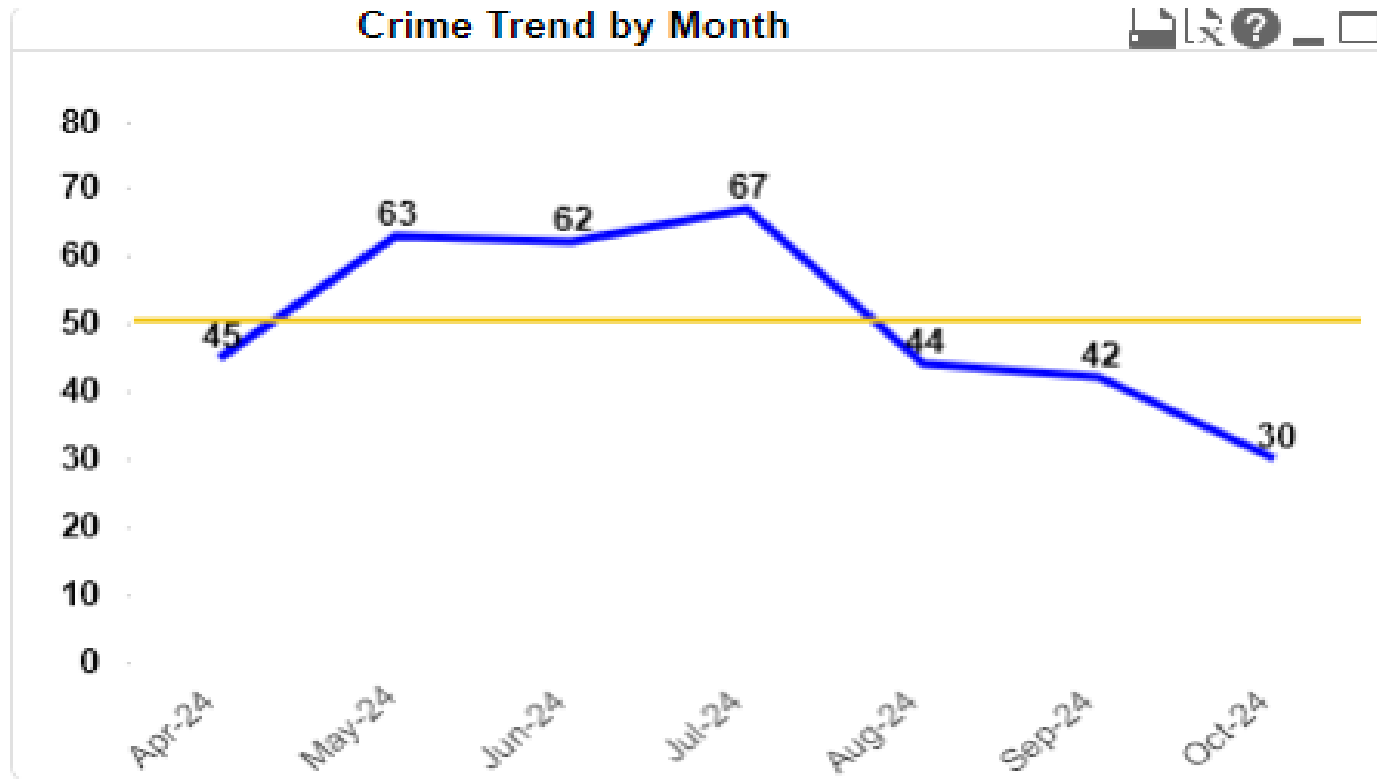

Crime Trend by Month



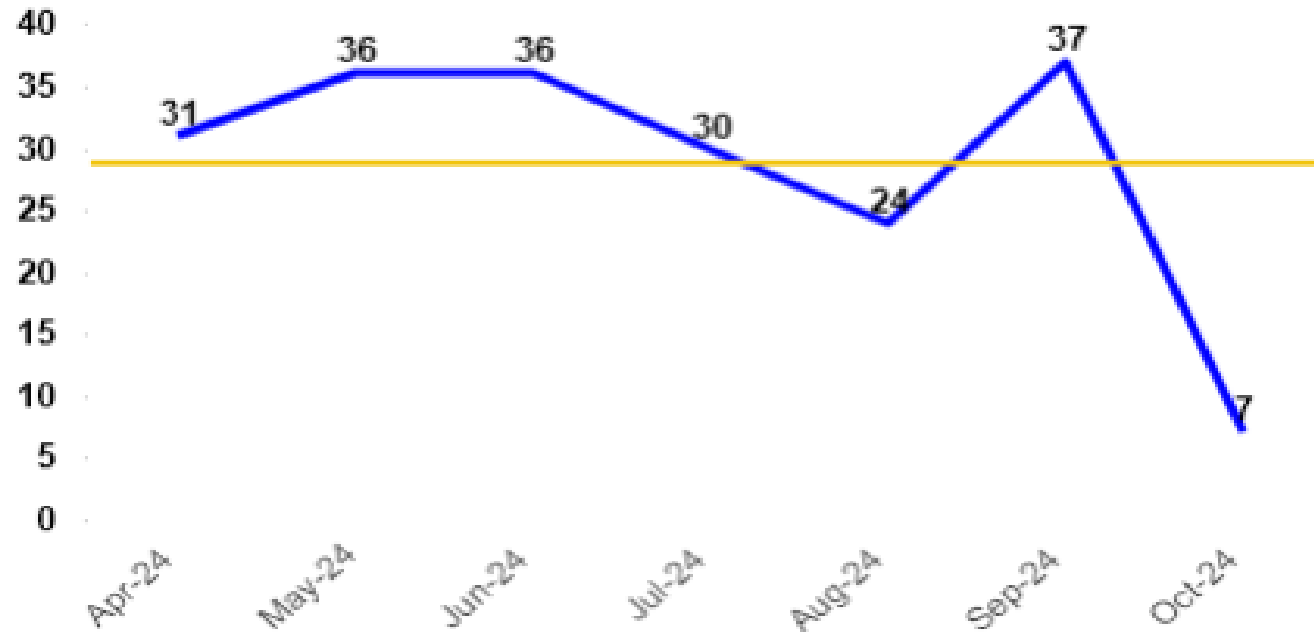
Violence without Inj

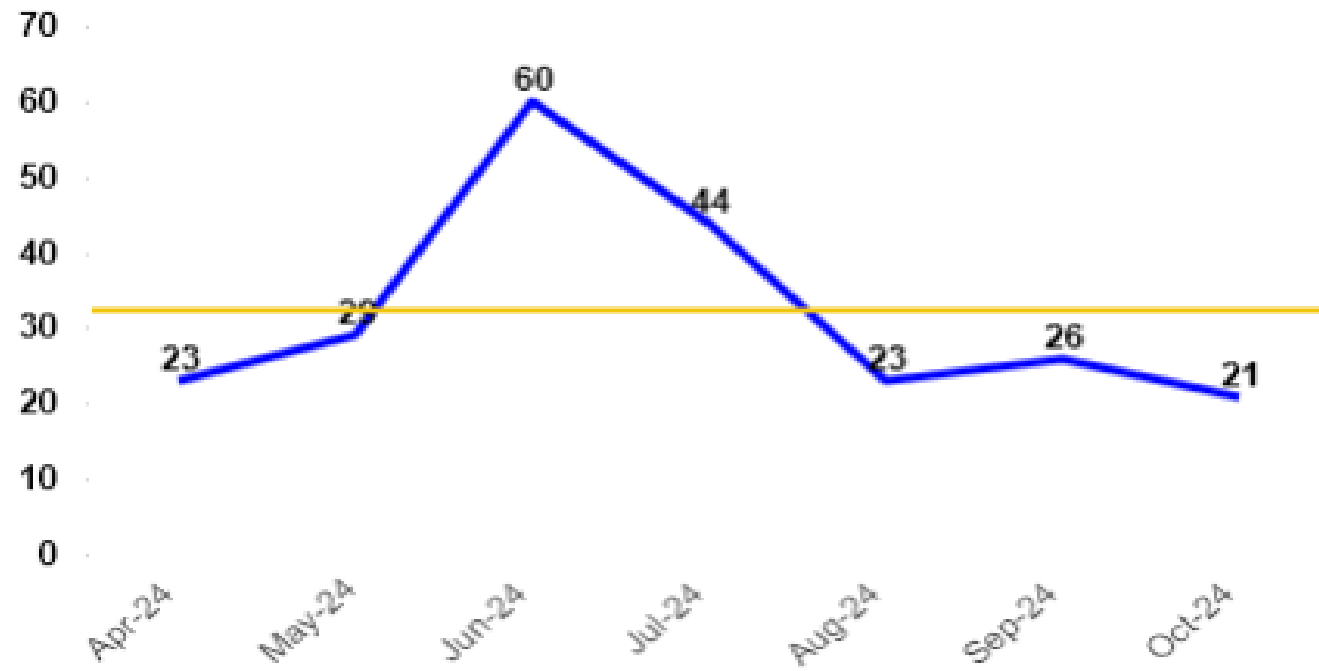
Crime Trend by Month

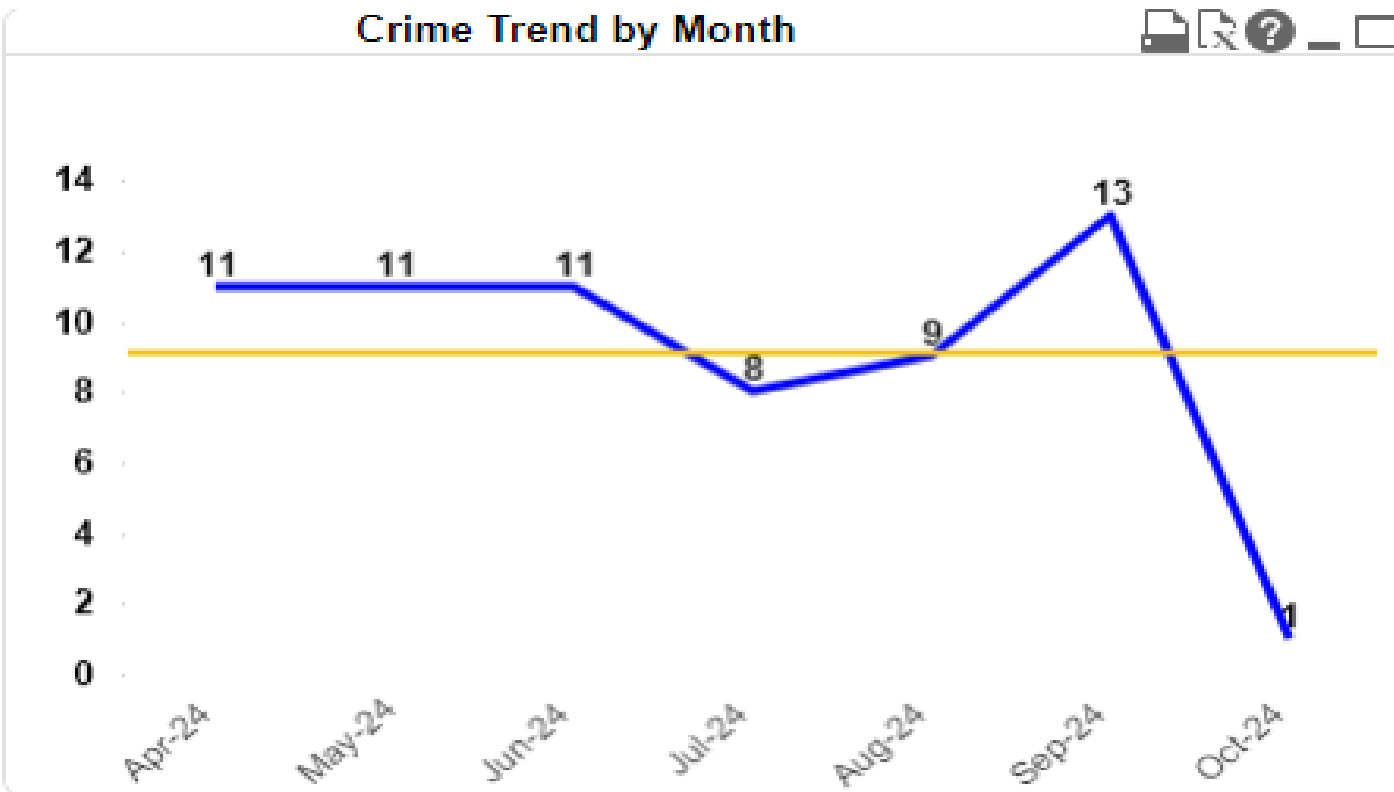
Crime Trend by Month



Drug offences



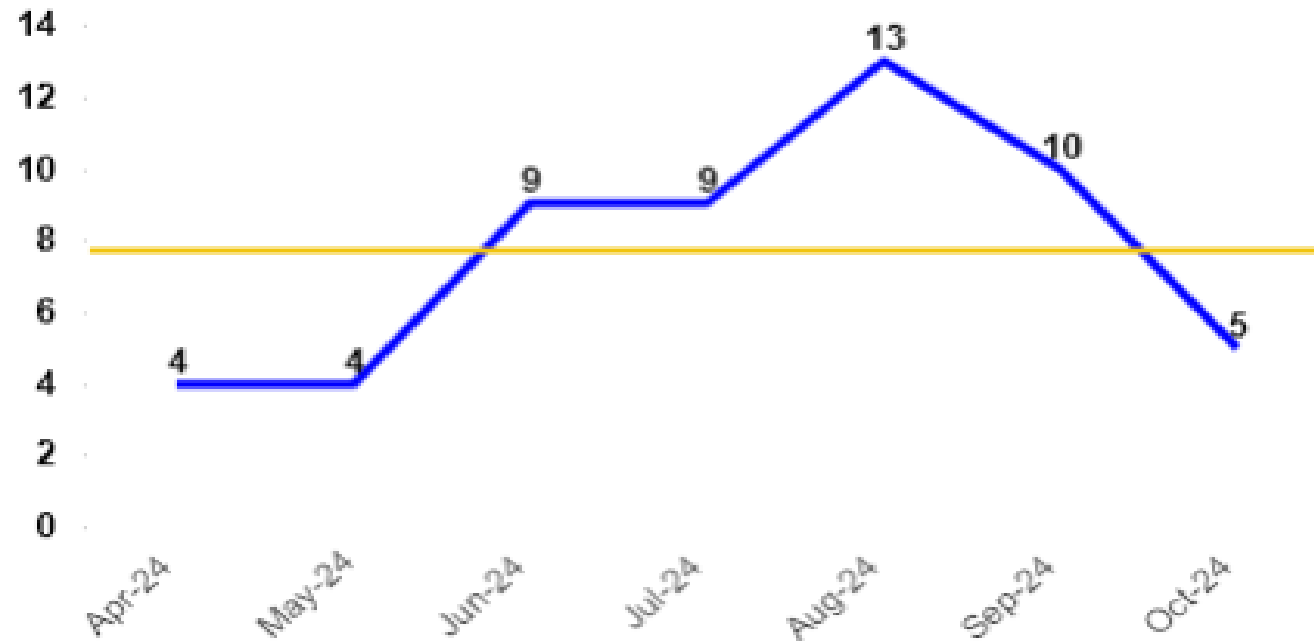
Crime Trend by Month

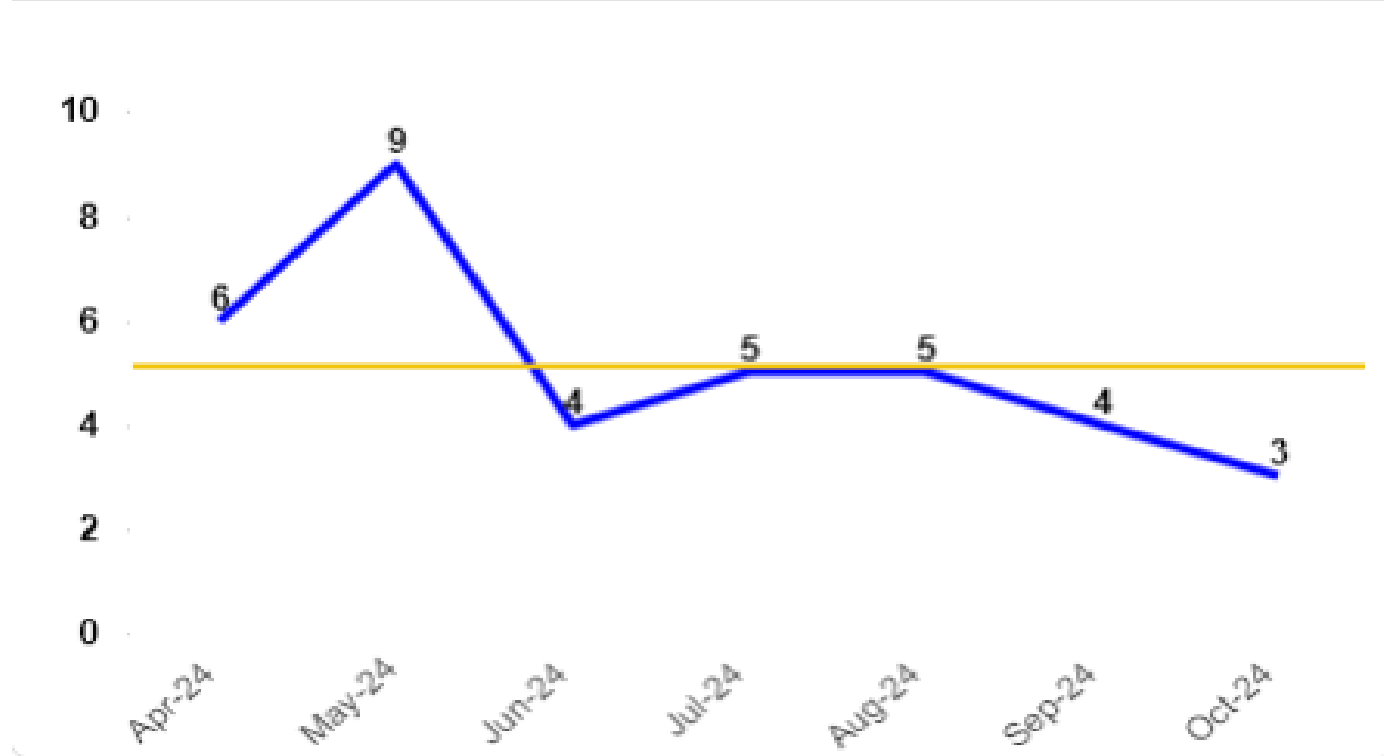
Crime Trend by Month
