Priorities for the area and Updates

Anti Social Behaviour

Continued focus Upper Dock Street – calls have reduced drastically for asb in that area Operation Lumley – dedicated officers every other night in our hotpsot areas of High street and Cambrian Road, responsible for 21 arrests, 19 stop searches and 5 community resolution.

Night Time Economy

City Safe model in place, dedicated neighbourhood teams completing the evening targeted phase and then staffing is supplemented by response officers till early hours.







Gwent Police Safe City Report Crimes and ASB

From November 2024 to the end of January 2025 there were 224 reported Crimes of Violence with injury, Public Order offences and Criminal Damage, as outlined in the scope on Slide 2 in Stow Hill Ward. There have been decreases month on month. The top offence types are S.4 POA (causing intentional harassment) & ABH showing notable numbers and accounting for over half of all offences (55%).

There were 165 reports of ASB during this time, which has seen fairly similar levels of incidents reported across the past 3 months, although December and January had lower numbers reported when compared to November.




